- 1 - Using a travel agent or doing your own online search both work well. Price around & find options that suit you best.
- 2 - Purchase your tickets with a credit card that includes travel insurance or purchase additional insurance. It generally doesn't cost that much & can save you loads of headaches when traveling internationally.
- 3 - There are NO direct flights between Vienna & Philadelphia. NONE.
- 4 - We tend to fly with European airlines (British Airways, Austrian - they wear BRIGHT RED uniforms!), but all airlines are fine. Look for one that best fits your budget & schedule. If you can sneak in a long layover in a new city - go for it! It is like a mini-vacation within a vacation - imagine lunch in Paris! That said, Elizabeth's mom swears that direct flights are without question the best option.
